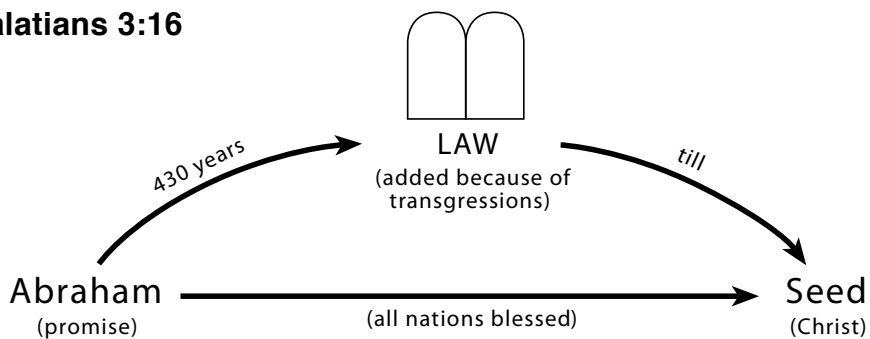


We are not under the ten commandments today

- 1 The Bible teaches that the law of God and the law of Moses are **one and the same**, and both expressions are used interchangeably.
Ezra 7:6
Ezra 7:12
Nehemiah 8:1
2 Chronicles 31:3
Luke 2:22-24
- 2 God gave the law to Moses.
Ezra 7:6
- 3 Moses gave the law of God.
2 Chronicles 34:14
- 4 There was only **one law** given at Sinai (ordinances, laws, statutes, commandments were all given together).
Nehemiah 9:13-14
- 5 Moses gave the ten commandments.
Mark 7:10
- 6 Moses gave the law.
John 7:19
- 7 The ten commandments were given to the nation of Israel and **no other** nation.
Deuteronomy 5:1-22
- 8 The Sabbath of the ten commandments was a memorial of the deliverance of the **children of Israel** from Egypt.
Deuteronomy 5:15
- 9 Christians were commanded **not** to let the Jews force them to keep the Sabbath, one of the ten commandments.
Colossians 2:16

- 10 The handwriting of requirements, the ten commandments, has been **taken out** of the way.
Colossians 2:14
- 11 The **covenant** God made with Israel when He brought them out of Egypt was the ten commandments.
Deuteronomy 4:13
1 Kings 8:9
- 12 God took away the **covenant** He made with Israel.
Hebrews 8:6-13
- 13 The law had to be changed.
Hebrews 7:12
- 14 Christ took away the first that He might establish the second.
Hebrews 10:9-10
- 15 Paul was discussing the law that included one of the ten commandments: “You shall not covet.”
Romans 7:7
- 16 Paul said Jews have been **delivered from** that law.
Romans 7:6
- 17 Those who would try to live by both old and new law commit **spiritual adultery**.
Romans 7:1-4
- 18 The law was added because of transgressions **til** the Seed should come.
Galatians 3:19
- 19 That Seed is Christ.
Galatians 3:16



Galatians 3:16-19

20 Christ came not to destroy the law, but to **fulfil** it.

Matthew 5:17-18

21 On the cross He said, “It is finished.” After His resurrection, Jesus said He **had fulfilled** the law, the prophets and the psalms.

Luke 24:44

22 We must **now hear Christ**, not Moses or Elijah (representing the law and the prophets).

Matthew 28:18

23 If we try to be justified by the law, including the ten commandments, we have **fallen from grace**.

24 Those who love Jesus will keep **His** commandments.

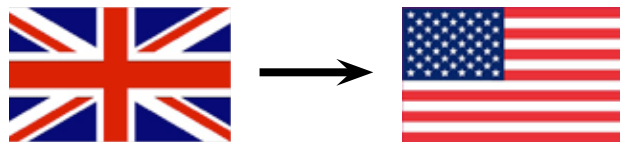
John 14:15

26 Through Christ we now have a **better covenant**.

Consider the changing of the law similar to the time when the colonies switched from British rule (old) to U.S. rule (new). Murder did not suddenly become permissible simply because the British rule of law was removed from the 13 colonies. The American law replaced it, which also stated that murder was against the law, only now there was a different jurisdiction – a new law. Many of the old laws did not carry over, but the “basic morality” ones did.
